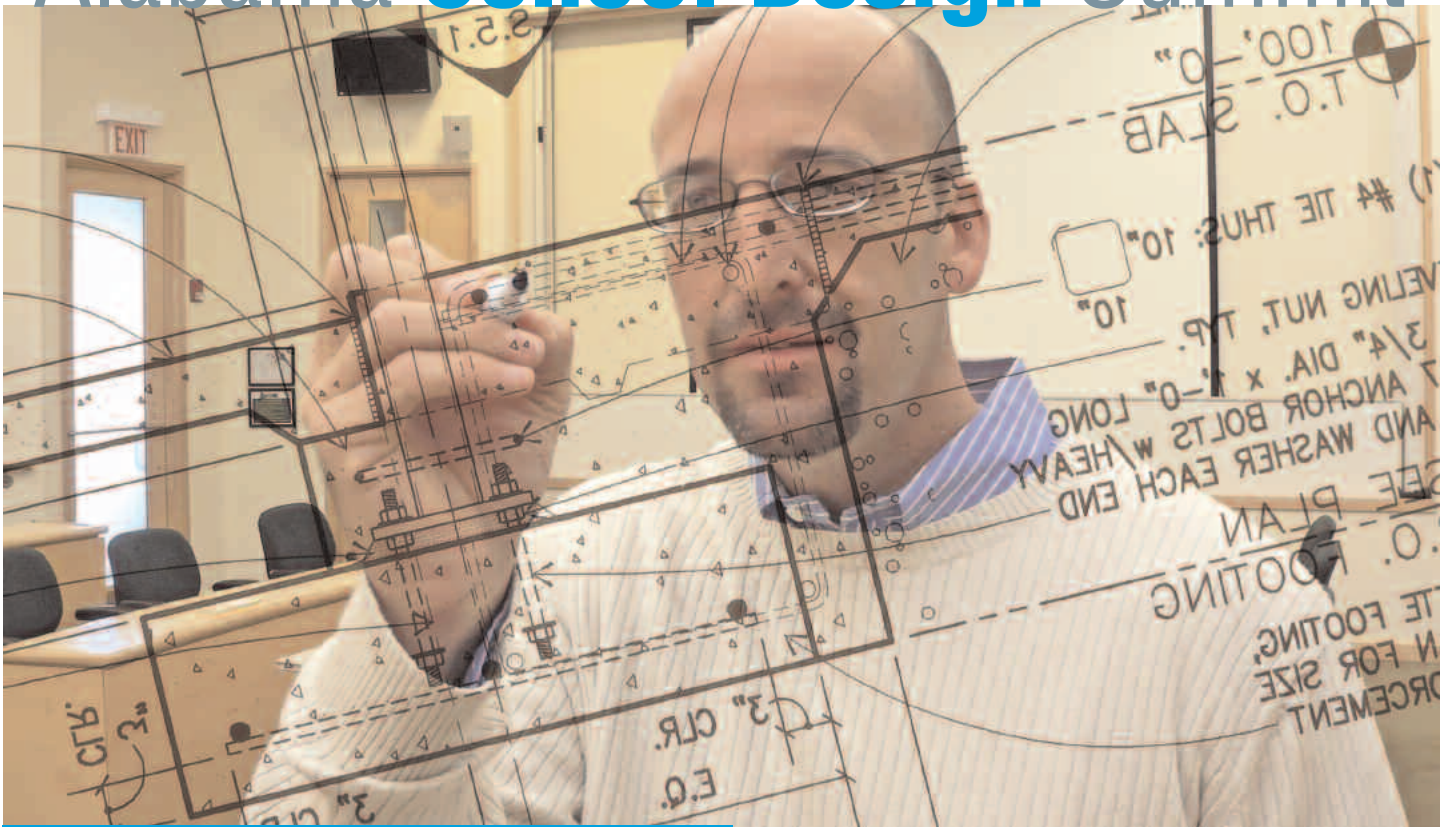


Alabama **School Design** Summit
